A training programme on First Aid (Voucher) has been organised from 27-29 April 2023 at IRCS-OSB for YRC & JRC Counsellor. The objective of the training is to provide potentially lifesaving techniques that an individual can be trained to perform with minimal equipment and they can be able to provide emergency services as on when required. We trained them on different topics like: Recovery position, Bleeding, Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), Fracture, Choking, Burns, Poisoning, Dressing & Bandage, Different types of Fracture & causality transportation etc. All the participants have participated actively and practised and organised scenario on different topics.





Sri Jaydev Rout, Brand ambassador of Federation of Blood Donor Organisations of India is traveling throughout the country in Cycle to spread awareness on blood donation. The main objective of this journey is "Har Ghar Rakt Data" to save priceless lives. He has already covered 12 States like Jharkhand, Bihar, Uttarpradesh, Delhi, Haryana, Punjab, Jammu, Rajastan, Gujarat, Maharstra, Chhatisgarh and Odisha.
