
MONTHLY ACTIVITIES REPORT May, 2023

Observance of World Red Cross Day-2023

This year the theme focuses on foregrounding the volunteers of Red Cross and their contribution to the society. The main objective of the theme isto highlight the universal, human and diverse aspect of the Red Cross Movement by focusing on volunteers and their involvement within communities.

To mark the day, a State Level Function was organized at the Red Cross Bhavan, Bhubaneswar in which all officers & staff members of IRCS, OSB, 200 local YRC & JRC Volunteers/ Counselors and Life members participated under the guidance of Honorary Secretary.

<u>Distribution of Relief Materials and Hygiene kits</u> atMauyrbhanjDistrict from 3rd May to 8th May ,2023

During the Hon'ble President's visit to Mayurbhanj District, A team of Staff members of IRCS-OSB started their journey with relief materials for 620 households for distribution at Uparbedha (Birth Place of Hon'ble President), Kusumi Rairangpur Mayurbhanj and school kits for students of SLS Residential School Pahadpur and for Orphans on 3rd May 2023. Activities details:

ON 3rd May, the team members organiseda meeting with Mr. Subodh Singh, Nominee of Managing body, NHQ, New Delhi at SLS Residential school, Pahadpur for a grand welcome to Hon'ble President Smt. Droupadi Murmu and for distribution of relief materials at Uparbeda on 5th May 2023 and 06th May 2023. The team members also planned for relief distribution at Rairangpur to needy Khadia and Mankadia Tribals on 7th May 2023 and also different programmes at Baripada with DRCB Mayurbhanj on 8th May 2023.





On the 4th May 2023 the president of India, Smt Daupradi Murmu visited to Pahadpur village at 10 AM. The whole team of Red Cross divided into two teams . One Team consisting of Volunteers and counsellors of Badampahad Govt. High School and YRC Counsellors and Volunteers of Badampahad formed a human chain near the helipad at Badampahad School for welcoming the Hon'ble President . Other Team Staff members of IRCS OSB , JRCO Mayurbhanj remained in side the SLS School Phadpur for welcome the President. From Helipad to SLS school Red Cross offered a grand welcome with slogans on Health , Service and Friendship. Then The President met with her native relatives and made conversation with the villagers. Then she visited SLS Residential School. JRC Counsellor, Volunteers of SLS School and Staff members of IRCS OSB welcomed to the Hon'ble President & Hon'ble Governor with Red Cross Clap. Hon'ble President and Governor distributed chocolates to the students . After the President's Programme, the School kits were distributed to the Students of SLS Residential School.





On 5th&6th May 2023 ,Different relief materials like Tarpaulin, Kitchen set, Hygiene Kit, Mosquito Net, Bucket, Mug and small Towel etc. were distributed families of different wards of Uparbeda. During the relief work Presidential Nominee Mr. Subodh Singh ,Sarapanchof Uperbeda village Mrs. Jamuna Hembram, Mr.Kinkong Mandal and Ramachandra Hembram (Childhood friend of President Madam) and other 5 Ward Members were present along with JRC Counsellors , YRC Counsellors and Volunteers.

Relief materials were also distributed to 10 families of Debrabeda a Hamletof Uparbeda who have been staying with no facilities like water, food, shelters etc.







On 7th May 2023 ,IRCS-OSB reached at Unreached village named Dibakacha where Khadia and Mankadia tribal people were living with transporting relief materials from Badampahad IB to Dibakatcha Village with a transport vehicle. The village is near about 40 km distance from Rairangapur head quarter. There was no communication to the village. The members reached at the village after travelling 2 km by foot. The Team members made a survey and found that there is also no other basic facilities available for the villagers. They are using fountain water to drink, No electricity and no livelihood. They basically depends upon on jungle fruits for their food. Many children were facing Mal-Nutrition due to Lack of nutrition foods. They are Consuming only rice and other Jungle Foods like Mango, Emili ,ragi etc. The children are not going to school or Anganwadi due to lack of awareness among the community people. During the relief distribution work, local Sarapanch, Jilla Parishad Anganwadi worker, Asa Didi , JRC Counsellors and YRC Counsellors were present. About this critical situation of the villagers was also communicated to the ADM and Emergency officer by the State team . They have given their voice to short out the Water issue as soon as possible.


