
Inaugural function of Social Service Camp on the occasion of Car Festival -2023

Car Festival -2023

Like every year, Indian Red Cross Society Odisha State Branch in association with District Red Cross Branch, Puri, Youth Red Cross and Junior Red Cross joined with District Administration Puri and Temple Administration Puri for providing different services to the lakhs of devotees during car festival.

Red Cross supported District administration for smooth functioning of Car festival. Before festival many preparatory meeting were held with different departments like police personnel for safety and security and green corridor for leaving a way to ambulance from any point of badadanda to District Medical Puri, with Municipality, Puri for a Swatchha Rathayatra, with RWSS for providing sufficient drinking water for the devotees combat hot and to humid condition of Puri, with Health department for providing different services like stretcher service, first aid service etc. and also with Other departments. A special meeting was held under the leadership of Chief Minister of Odisha for taking a review on different activities to be held during the car festival.





▶ Before RathYatra a mock drill was held on 16th June 2023 in which different stake holders joined. Red Cross also joined with NDRF, ODRAF, and Fire Personnel for the mock drill.







➤ On 19th June 2023 there was an inaugural function of Red Cross for inauguration of Car Festival Social service Camp 2023 on 5 PM at Gopabandhu Ayurvedic College, Puri. Hon'ble Governor of Odisha cum President of IRCS OSB joined as chief guest 'Hon'ble Minister Health & Family Welfare Dept. Govt of Odisha cum Chairman State IRCS OSB working Committee and Hon'ble Minister Higher Education Dept. Govt of Odisha cum Chairman State Youth red Cross Working Committee joined as guest. In this inaugural function, More than 600 Red Cross Volunteers from Youth Red Cross, Junior Red Cross, District Red Cross, Life Members and Staff members joined the social service camp for rendering different services to the devotees.





Drinking Water Service and water sprinkling (Cool Initiation)

Special arrangements were made in view of the prevailing hot and humid conditions in Puri. Drinking water, Lemon Water and ORS water were distributed to the devotees to combat heat





First Aid Service: Red Cross engaged more than 450 volunteers in rendering first aid services at the 29 first aid centers opened by Govt.. The whole volunteers were divided into groups which were led by Lay Lecturers in first aid and SERV Trainers. More volunteers were engaged at two major points like Utkal Hindi Vidyapitha and District Head quarter Hospital for providing first aid services and stretcher services. > Train Tragedy at Bahanaga, Balasore:

On the 2nd June, 2023 three trains collided at Bahanaga of Balasore District. Salimar Chennai Coromandal Express, Yashwantpur Hawarh Super fast Express collided with a stationary freight train. Near about 300 people died & thousand injured. On the same day Dr. Ramesh Chandra Behera,YRCO and Laxman Swain,JRCO himself rushed to the train accidental spot at Bahanaga and coordinated all the emergency services with mobilizing counsellors and volunteers & provided emergency services like First-aid, crowed management, dead body management carrying the injured to hospital etc. They also provided food, water to the injured person at different Hospitals like Soro, Balasore, Bhadrak & Cuttack. For providing Blood to the accidental victims, YRC/JRC Counsellors of Balasore, Bhadrak & Cuttack arranged blood donation Camp & donated blood to save many priceless lives. They also distributed cooked food & water to the relatives of the victims, the persons engaged in rescue operation like fire men, ODRAF, NDRF etc.
