- Monthly Food Basket (Nutrition Food Packets) distributed to 547 TB Patients at Koraput District.
- Micro Cellular Rubber(MCR) Foot wears has been distributed among the Leprosy Patients at different Leprosy Colonies in Bhubaneswar (local).
- A. Under the guidance of Honorary Secretary Indian Red Cross Society Odisha State Branch, distributed Micro Cellular Rubber footwears to 08 leprosy patients Gopabandhu Leprosy Colony, Buddha Nagar, Bhubaneswar. Lack of different designs and colours decrease the acceptability of footwear among the leprosy patients which is a major obstacle on the way for complete eradication of leprosy patients. Keeping this on view, with the help of Lepra Society Odisha Red Cross prepared MCR Footwears for the leprosy patients. These upgraded and newer designs of protective MCR distributed by Red Cross was accepted by the leprosy patients. These footwears footwears definitely prevent ulcers, protect and cover their anaesthetic and deformed feet. During the programme, Staffs of Lepra Society and IRCS OSB were present. The Gopabandhu Leprosy colony members praised Red Cross initiative for this noble job.

The programme was held by involving 70 above local residents including adolescent girls, women, men, Asha and Anganwadi workers. The main objective of the Awareness programme was to promote family counselling. With the span of time and introduction of modernity the value of family life in some cases have been

derogated. With small misunderstandings the family life become strained and lead to divorce or judicial separation. In these cases most of the time they need a third party intervention who can discuss with them and can resolve the misunderstandings. There was discussion on various issues related to family counselling centre including Dowry, Domestic violence, Extramarital relation, Family property dispute, premarital Counselling etc.

A. Construction of Sheds for Blood Collection Bus

IRCS-OSB has constructed a Shed on 30.07.2023 for Blood Collection Bus (5 Seater) in the premises to protect the bus from heavy rains, dust, storm, wind, insects. It also protects the bus from birds drooping that usually happens when we park our bus on open space. Thus bus parking sheds become very effective to reduce the maintenance cost.
