## Monitoring /Assesement

1. As per information from Anganwadi Didi, It is assessed that the children/ infant whose health condition was in red zone i. e. Severe acute malnutrition now improved due to the food supplement provided by Red Cross and they are now not in red zone.
2. It is observed that some children can now write all. The whole team motivated the children to read for a good life and to play for a good health. All parents promised to send their babies in time for learning to the Awangan Wadi Centre.
3. Keeping the rainy season in view, the whole team created awareness among the villagers for drinking safe drinking water to be free from jaundice and other waterborne diseases and also to use mosquito net provided by Red Cross to combat dengue and malaria.
4. The team members also discussed with different dept. for proper communication to village, for providing seeds for growing vegetables and also to provide livestock for their livelihood.
5. The PWD department of Nayagarh district has 60 % completed the Kachha Road from Banthapur village to Nepal Village after the reporting by IRCS-OSB.
